



FACT SHEET FOR DELEGATES

Dress Code for Event: For Military members – Military Uniform (Dress of the Day).
Civilian - Business Casual – Suit with no tie, jacket optional (Dress Pants and Business Shirt)

Accommodation: Accommodation will be confirmed during your registration process when you place your Credit Card details in the accommodation section. Your Credit Card details are simply taken to secure the booking; your card is not charged at this point. Delegates must pay for their stay upon check in/out depending on the hotels policy.

Weather in Sydney in June: In the month of June, the average daytime temperatures are generally around **14°C** in the city while the average high temperature can reach 18°C on the warmest days. Sydney never gets too cold, even in the winter. Average minimum temperatures generally tend to be around 10° C.

Visa and Immigration Requirements for Sydney: Australia welcomes millions of overseas visitors each year. Anyone who is not an Australian citizen needs a valid visa to enter and spend time here.

There are different visas for family and skilled migrants, tourists, business people, sports people, students and others. Many visas can be applied for online, and the Electronic Travel Authority can be applied for through travel agents and airlines. New Zealanders are granted an electronic visa on arrival in Australia.
